Not all people in a specific target group have the need for easy-to-read materials It is also important to recognize that there is often an overlap among those groups that can benefit from easy-to-read materials Persons with disabilities A wide variety of disabilities can cause reading problems and thus create a need for easy-to-read materials

to the next idea People are confused when materials skip back and forth between topics Avoid lengthy lists Create short lists (3-7 items) with bullets, not commas People with limited reading skills tend to forget items in longer lists If you have a long list, break it into subheads 3 Tell audiences what they need to do
